D32 Already supporting the shop at Bishops Caundle

D31 - Pulham/Bishops Caundle

D27 - employee has a child there / D31 Be ideal near the village hall but could work elsewhere

When our children were young we used and supported the nursery school in Holwell / If a recreation space was created, it should be either sited near the village hall or near the Nursery school but suitable pathways would have to be in place for children to safely access

D28 VERY RARELY

D27 No connection with Nursery School / D30 Any recreation area would be used by dog walkers who never pick up They would come by car as they do at present in the Drove. Alweston and Bishops Caundle suffer this problem

D32 We found no support for a village shop

D29 To even consider to have a recreation area roads need to be sorted first Too dangerous to walk / D32 Many have tried running a P/O shop and have had to close due to lack of support. Howell too small to make a small business pay

There is shop at Bishops Caundle and an additional shop in Holwell may cause this to shut

D32 we use the shop at Bishops Caundle from time to time and a shop in Holwell would not be viable

D27 not now but used to / D30 by Youth Club and meeting point / If a green field was able to be used for recreation then a shop nearby would also be used BUT because of costs would not be viable against local supermarkets & deliveries
