SAH stated that the main focus of the meeting is to review the site assessment scores supplied by Working Group Members.

Jo Witherden asked all the Working Group members to remember that that this is the 1<sup>st</sup> step in a longer process and their assessments form the basis of proposals for residents to review. She stated that we are not making decisions but are reviewing and proposing which sites are more or less likely to be suitable for development of any kind in line with the wishes of the residents of Holwell. The recommendations made by the WG will then go out for public consultation.

**6. Site Assessments**

**Details of assessments will be issued separately; however some of the key points discussed during the assessment session are noted here**

SAH had received ten sets of scores and had consolidated them by site for the 19/20 sites for review. She had produced both average and median scores for each objective and overall for each site. Individual scores were shown on each sheet by site so assumptions could be reviewed and discussed as appropriate.

Three of the assessors were not present. SAH had not produced any scores for inclusion and was taking the notes at this review session.

PhC asked whether we are looking at sites as suitable for housing or whether we were to define the type of housing that a site could support. SAH stated that we are looking at whether the site is suitable for housing development of some sort, not how many or what type.

PC had stated on his assessment sheet that, as far as possible, we should retain hedgerows and trees on boundaries or within sites.

JE stated that she had assumed 1 house per plot with the exception of the Magna site.

It was confirmed that all decisions made during this process need to be group decisions and that individuals scores for each site will not be made available to the public at the July consultation.

Regarding Objective 6, it was discussed that PhC had scored each site as 2 and LW had scored each site as 0; it was agreed that these scores were valid as each individual had reason/logic to score this way.
