

Site at Trims Ground, Stony Lane

SITE DESCRIPTION

This is a sloping, open rural field used as pasture land, with residential to either side fronting onto Stony Lane. There are a substantial amount of trees and hedges bordering the site. The plot is visible from Stony Lane and the residential property to the South and can be glimpsed from the main road.

PROPOSED USE

Housing to the front of the plot, fishing lake and tourist facilities / accommodation to rear

ACCESS

There is existing access for vehicle and pedestrians

ENVIRONMENT AND LOCAL FEATURES

The land is considered to be marshy and unimproved grassland so there is the possibility of wildlife habitats. There are trees and hedges bordering the site. The site is visible in distant views from the rear of the listed Elm Tree Farm.

TRANSPORT DEVELOPMENT LIAISON

Site could be okay if visibility splays can be provided (2.4m by 43m in each direction)

OTHER

Neighbouring properties are residential
